

Grants Guidance Notes

Grants are made to people who are in need and live in the town of Guildford. The area we cover is shown on our website - www.guildfordpoylecharities.org. Grants are given in the form of vouchers for suppliers with whom we have arrangements, or a BACS payment to the agency which referred you.

What you can apply for

We can give grants for things such as:

- Kitchen items and appliances
- Second-hand furniture
- Household items
- Clothing
- Second-hand computers
- Holiday playschemes

These are just examples – other things will be considered but please contact us to check if you are unsure. Grants are not usually given for basic items such as food, rent, utility bills, debt or arrears.

References

Your grant application is more likely to be successful if it is supported by a letter from a professional (for example a health visitor, social worker, home school link worker or housing support officer) who knows your circumstances; we may contact them to discuss your application. They may also apply on your behalf.

Data Protection

By submitting an application you consent to the information you provide being processed by the charity. You also consent to us contacting your referee. The information that you give us together with any supplementary information that you and your referee give us by email, letter or telephone will be presented to the awarding committee of trustees. We will keep your personal information securely in electronic form for up to seven years and in paper form for up to three years from your last contact with us. Other than our contact with your referee we do not allow information identifiable to you to go outside the charity.

Information for Referees

In order to help us understand whether a grant has had the intended effect and helped your client to move on we may contact you for an evaluation three months after any award.
